ADMISSIONS POLICY

1. Policy Statement

Charterhouse Almaty offers an academically selective and ambitious education, equipping young people to meet the challenges of life beyond a Charterhouse education. As well as a broad academic curriculum, there is great variety and depth in the wider education on offer.

Each application for a place at Charterhouse Almaty is considered in accordance with the strict selection criteria of the school and is based on the assurance that the school will be able to educate and develop the student to reach their potential in line with the standards set by the vision and values of the school.

2. Aims

The school:

- sets selection criteria and procedures that are fair to all applicants;
- identifies applicants whose academic ability matches the vision and values of the school, and whose personal qualities suggest that they have the potential to contribute significantly to an academically challenging school environment.
